

Views From the Proposed Alignment Structure

Alternative 7 - Havana Route

H - Rural, with unobstructed view of Mount St. Michael Scholasticate Monastery structure atop hillside. High Vividness, Medium Intactness and Unity.

I - Petroleum Storage tanks gives an Industrial view to a Rural area. Proposed raised Roadway Structure will provide visual access. Low Vividness, Intactness, and Unity.

J - Kaiser Plant Industrial Structure creates an eyesore in a Rural landscape. Proposed raised roadway structure will provide visual access. Low Vividness, Intactness, and Unity.

K - Automobile junkyard and Industrial/Construction Stockyard bordering Residential/Retail area. Proposed raised Roadway Structure will provide visual access. Low Vividness, Intactness, and Unity.

Alternative 6 - Market/Greene Route

L - Similar assessment as "B" of Beacon Hill area in Background.

M - View of Spokane River Eastward. Spokane Falls Community College on South bank is separated from the Residential neighborhood on the North Bank by the River. Industrial area in Middleground. High Intactness and Unity in Foreground and Background.

N - View of Spokane River Westward. Residential neighborhoods on North and South banks are separated by the River, but maintain Medium Unity. High Intactness and Unity in Foreground.

O - Similar assessment as "H" of Mount St. Michael Scholasticate in Background.

P - Similar assessment as "J" of R.A. Hanson Industrial Structure in Middleground.


