


US 2 LOWERING CONTRACT



Contract Description:

This contract will lower US 2 between Farwell Road and Deadman Creek, construct six bridges and multiple retaining walls for the NSC/US 2 Interchange, and complete the mainline paving through the interchange. The contract also includes the construction of a frontage road system along US 2.

Planned Advertisement Date: Fall 2008

ACTUAL - Advertisement Date: August 18, 2008

Contract Funds: \$55.5 million total funds, \$25.9 million Nickel and \$29.6 million Special Category "C" funds.

Interesting Facts:

- Interchange configuration designed to address perched water tables.
- Constructs six bridges with a total deck area of 77,190 square feet. The longest bridge is 980 feet.
- Work includes constructing several retaining walls totaling over 100,000 square feet.
- This contract will complete the NSC/US 2 Interchange.
- At Deadman Creek a new 30-foot-wide arch structure will replace the existing box culvert, allowing for fish passage and wildlife migration along the creek.
