Check out the refined design concepts for SR 520 in Seattle at our public open house on the 11th of September

Please join us at our public meeting on Sept. 11 in Montlake to learn more about updated design concepts for SR 520 improvements in the Seattle area. In 2012, the Seattle Community Design Process resulted in a series of well-supported refinements to west side elements. This summer, design professionals have been working hard to address key questions that remained. Staff with the Washington State Department of Transportation and the city of Seattle will be on-hand to share the latest design renderings, answer your questions, and hear your feedback.

At the meeting, you can learn about the overall corridor vision and refined design features of the:

- New Portage Bay Bridge (such as bridge type and options for a bicycle/pedestrian path)
- New Montlake lid (such as functionality and connectivity)
- Non-motorized connections on and around the corridor in Seattle

You can also chat with staff about progress across the SR 520 corridor, including Eastside and floating bridge construction, upcoming West Approach Bridge North construction, and various mitigation projects.

West Approach Bridge North Project construction planned to begin this fall

In July, WSDOT awarded the \$199.5 million contract to Flatiron West Inc. and is scheduled to begin construction in the Montlake area and on Lake Washington this fall.
