ORDINANCE #466

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE TOWN OF WILBUR TO BE THE PERMITTING AUTHORITY FOR STATE MANAGED ACCESS HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN OF WILBUR CORPORATE LIMITS AND TO AMEND THE WILBUR MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 12, STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES TO INCLUDE A SECTION THERETO

WHEREAS, the Town of Wilbur corporate limits include state highways 2 and 21; and

WHEREAS, current law requires cities and towns to be the permitting authorities for state managed access highways within their boundaries; and

WHEREAS, current law requires cities and towns to adopt access permitting standards for these highways that meet or exceed the state's access standards; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILBUR, COUNTY OF LINCOLN, STATE OF WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOW, TO WIT:

SECTION 1. State Highways as determined by WSDOT

SECTION 2. Wilbur Municipal Code Amended

Wilbur Municipal Code, Title 12, is amended to include Chapter 12.15 titled State Highway Access Management.

SECTION 3. Purpose

This chapter is adopted to implement RCW Chapter 47.50, for the regulation and control of vehicular access and connection points of ingress to, and egress from the state highways within the incorporated limits of the Town of Wilbur.

SECTION 4. Adoption by Reference.

Pursuant to the requirements and authority of Chapter 47.50 RCW, there is hereby adopted by reference the provisions of Chapters 468-51 and 468-52 WAC, together with all future amendments, in order to implement the requirements of Chapter 47.50 RCW.

SECTION 5: Nonliability:

Nothing contained in this ordinance is intended to be, construed to create or form the basis for any liability on the part of the Town authority, or their respective officers, employees or agents, for any injury or damage resulting from the failure of any person to comply with the terms of this chapter, or by reason or in consequence of any omission in connection with the implantation or enforcement of this ordinance on the part of the Town and its officers, employees or agents.

SECTION 6: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 7:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

SECTION 8:

The attached ordinance summary is hereby approved and the Town Clerk is directed to publish the same in the Town's official newspaper pursuant to RCW 35.27.300.

SECTION 9:

This ordinance shall be in effect after its passage, approval and publication.
