## SR 14 construction and traffic impacts - Summer 2010

*WSDOT helps drivers plan ahead and know before they go*

### Why is WSDOT closing the highway?

To protect motorists from potential rockfall, WSDOT will remove loose rock, unstable soil, trees, and other debris from slopes above SR 14 in two locations - the Dog Mountain and White Salmon areas.

For the safety of drivers and construction crews, SR 14 must be closed while crews perform blasting and rock scaling work.

### SR 14 near Dog Mountain closure schedule

#### March 1 - June 14

SR 14 will be closed from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m., seven days a week.

#### June 15 - September 2

Between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m., seven days a week, SR 14 will be closed for two hour durations and reopened for an hour inbetween.

- **Before 8 a.m. - OPEN to single-lane traffic**
- 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. - CLOSED
- **10 a.m. to 11 a.m. - OPEN to single-lane traffic**
- 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. - CLOSED
- **1 p.m. to 2 p.m. - OPEN to single-lane traffic**
- 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. - CLOSED
- **After 4 p.m. - OPEN to single-lane traffic with automated signal**
