
WSDOT thanks you for your patience on this project to rebuild ramps to current ADA standards.

In spring and summer 2016, WSDOT reconstructed numerous curb ramps along State Routes 303 and 3 near Bremerton. The curb ramps were rebuilt to meet current ADA standards. Along with that work, crews will also built portions of sidewalks in the vicinity of the curb ramps.

To help keep local residents and businesses informed of work progress and its location, WSDOT updated this document weekly.


