Studies have shown that accidents resulting from excessive speed involve greater risk of serious injury or death than other kinds of accidents. In an effort to reduce these types of accidents, the State of Washington has adopted laws that allow automated camera enforcement of selected traffic safety statutes and ordinances. RCW 46.63.170 authorizes the installation and operation of automated cameras to enforce the state speed limits.

The images show the vehicle and its license plate, portray a fair and accurate representation of the location listed and show that the vehicle operator was driving with a speed over the speed limit posted. The registered owner of the vehicle is named on the front of this notice.

An infraction detected through the use of an automated traffic safety camera is a non-criminal offense for which imprisonment may not be imposed as a sanction. The penalty for this infraction, like a parking ticket, is not part of the violator's driving record. Therefore, a finding the infraction was committed, either by payment or after a hearing, will not be reported to the Department of Licensing. However, failure to respond to a Notice of Infraction, failure to appear for a hearing requested or failure to pay a penalty imposed after a hearing will result in a late fee as well as this Notice of Infraction being referred to a collections agency, additional penalties plus collection fees being added to the original penalty, and non-renewal of vehicle license.

State law provides that the registered owner of a vehicle is presumed to have operated the vehicle at the time an infraction was detected by an automated traffic safety camera.

IF YOUR VEHICLE WAS STOLEN OR WAS OTHERWISE NOT IN YOUR CARE, CUSTODY OR CONTROL AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION, you may submit a Declaration of Non-Responsibility to rebut the presumption, established in RCW 46.63.075, that the registered owner was driving the vehicle at the time of the violation. This Declaration will be made under oath that the car was at the time, stolen or in the care, custody, or control of some person other than the registered owner, a Declaration of Non-Responsibility form can be downloaded or printed at www.violationinfo.com.

EMPLOYERS: As a matter of law, a vehicle registered to an employer/principal that is driven by an employee/agent remains in the "care, custody, and control" of the employer/agent. Thus, the employer/principal is responsible for payment of the infraction penalty and may not transfer that responsibility by submitting a sworn statement. Like a parking infraction, an employee/agent may take responsibility for a traffic camera infraction by submitting payment directly to the Court or by requesting a hearing in his or her name.

Your response must be mailed no later than midnight of the due date shown on the front of this Notice of Infraction.

Your hearing options are:

MITIGATION HEARING: By requesting a mitigation hearing, you agree to appear at your scheduled hearing and will be deemed to have committed the infraction. You may not subpoena witnesses for this hearing. You would request a mitigation hearing if you agree the infraction was committed but believe the circumstances may be such that the court could reduce or waive the penalty. You will be notified in writing of your mitigation hearing date.

CONTESTED HEARING: At a contested hearing the State has the burden of proving by a preponderance of the evidence that the infraction was committed. By requesting a contested hearing, you agree to appear at your scheduled hearing. You may subpoena witnesses including the officer who issued this Notice of Infraction. You will be notified in writing of your contested hearing date.
