Peter Koonce, PE is a national expert in multimodal traffic operations, with public and private sector experience in the design, operation and maintenance of traffic signals, street lighting, multi-modal streets and ITS systems. He was a member of the NACTO Urban Streets Guide Steering Committee and is a current member of the Bicycle Technical Committee of the National Committee on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Target Audience

This course is designed for transportation engineers, street designers and other practitioners involved in or responsible for the planning, design, operations, or management of transportation facilities.

Training Description

This training for the National Association of City Transportation Officials (NACTO)'s Urban Bikeway Design Guide advances new principles to integrate innovative street design options considered as a part of projects to help communities promote a multimodal environment. The Guide has been endorsed by WSDOT and is included as a resource document for the WSDOT Local Agency Guidelines Manual. This training will provide specific examples where principles in the Guides are applied. It will help build technical expertise in the planning and design of emerging bicycle facilities. Critical themes for the training include safe intersection design for bicyclists, high quality protected and buffered bike lanes, and creating bicycle boulevards using targeted speed and volume management measures. This is a highly interactive training.
