



SR 704 Cross-Base Highway Project

The design of the proposed Cross-Base Highway (SR 704) beginning at the I-5 Thorne Lane interchange at the west, connecting to 176th Street at SR 7 is underway. As design progresses, the Washington State Department of Transportation (lead agency for the new corridor) will be holding two public open houses to meet with interested citizens about the project.

When completed, the Cross-Base Highway (SR 704) will provide regional travelers with a new six-mile-long, multi-lane divided highway. The new alternate east-west route will ease congestion on I-5, SR's 512 and 7, Spanaway Loop Road, and 174th Street, by providing a more direct travel route through Fort Lewis and McChord military bases.

WSDOT invites you to attend one of two open house meetings scheduled to present information about the design project. Both meetings will have identical information and will include an open house from 4-6 p.m. and a formal presentation from 6-7 p.m. These open house meetings provide the public with the opportunity to learn more about the project and to share your ideas with WSDOT staff responsible for developing the proposed designs.


