## Crews prepare mainline for next phase of construction

Following the April 19-22 weekend closure SR 520 corridor neighbors can expect construction crews to work around-the-clock Monday through Sunday, throughout the mainline corridor to complete the new SR 520 westbound lanes. The work will take about five weeks to complete as crews prepare the SR 520 mainline roadway to move the westbound lanes and begin the next phase of the project.

### Here are the details:

- **Date:** Beginning Monday, April 22 through the end of May
- **Time:** Around-the-clock shifts, including weekend work
- **Location:** SR 520 mainline between 84th Avenue Northeast and 92nd Avenue Northeast

### How will crews complete the work?

Crews will work around-the-clock during the week and weekends removing the existing roadway between 84th Avenue Northeast and 92nd Avenue Northeast, lowering the mainline lanes, and paving the new westbound lanes.

Crews will mill out and remove the existing roadway, then excavate and lower the westbound lanes, place new drainage utility lines, and lastly, grade and pave the new lanes.

### What can residents expect?

Residents in the area may hear nighttime noise such as asphalt milling, sawcutting, hauling material off site and paving. Residents may also hear trucks, equipment and back-up alarms.
