



All noise wall panels are installed!

We have finished installing all of the noise wall panels for Stage 1 of the project.

Thanks for your patience during night work, traffic detours, and ramp closures as we work to reduce noise coming from I-5 in your neighborhood.



Walls 2 and 3 have an ashlar stone finish, shown in the picture on the left. Wall 4 has a dry stack stone finish, seen on the right. The next step is to apply a tinted sealant to the noise walls.

Additional work on the noise walls

You will not notice the full benefit of the noise walls until crews seal the gaps between the panels, install access doors and backfill the space at the bottom of each panel.

Crews will also apply a tinted sealant to the noise wall to protect it from water damage. After the noise wall work is complete, crews will come back through the area and landscape the highway side of the noise walls, consistent with the existing vegetation. Crews will also plant grass on the neighborhood side of the noise wall to control erosion.

We plan to provide our suggestions for landscaping on the neighborhood side of the noise wall for residents to use if they choose to landscape near the noise wall.
