

# I-5 Closed, June 7-10

## Salmon Creek Interchange Project

I-5 closed in Salmon Creek, June 7 - 10

Construction of a new interchange bridge in Salmon Creek will close all lanes of I-5 just south of the I-205 junction from **11 p.m. Friday, June 7, to 5 a.m. Monday, June 10.**

### Northbound I-205

- Exit northbound I-205 at NE 134th Street (Exit 36)
- Merge onto NE 23rd Avenue


### Southbound I-5

- Exit southbound I-5 at NE 134th Street (Exit 7)
- Turn left onto NE 134th Street
- Turn left onto NE 23rd Avenue

### Southbound I-5 detour (peak traffic hours)

*The ramp to NE 134th St. will be closed during peak traffic hours. Use NE 179th St. as a detour route.*

- Exit southbound I-5 at NE 179 Street (Exit 9)
- Turn left onto NE 179th Street
- Turn right onto NE 15th Avenue
- Turn left onto NE 139th Street



## What should drivers do?

- ✓ **Check the impacts:** Take a close look at the closure map and compare it to your plans for the weekend. Will you be impacted by this work?
- ✓ **Don't drive:** If possible, arrange your schedule to avoid travel during the closure weekend.
- ✓ **Pick a detour route:** Plan your alternate route before you hit the road.
- ✓ **Expect delays:** Detouring traffic will add congestion to the other highways and local roads in Clark County. Wherever you're heading, expect delays and plan for extra travel time.

During the closure, crews will install 12 concrete bridge girders for the new NE 139th Street interchange. Each girder measures 165 feet long, weighs more than 87 tons and will take about three hours to secure in place above I-5.
