

You're invited to an unveiling of Seattle's most boring exhibit!

The world's largest diameter tunnel boring machine will arrive in Seattle next year, but you don't have to wait until then to check it out. At 6:30 p.m. on August 2, a 10-foot long, motorized model of the massive machine that will dig the SR 99 tunnel is making its debut at Milepost 31 in Pioneer Square.

Everyone is invited to join in the fun - history, engineering and construction buffs; kids that love construction equipment; First Thursday Art Walk visitors who appreciate creativity and ingenuity. There's something for everyone!
