

## Traffic shift at NE 70th Street and NE 85th Street ramps scheduled for February 14

As part of ongoing work to widen I-405 between Bellevue and Bothell, crews will shift traffic accessing northbound I-405 from the NE 70th Street on-ramp to the collector-distributor lane between NE 70th Street and NE 85th Street (see map at right). Motorists accessing northbound I-405 from the NE 70th Street on-ramp will need to travel a little ways to the NE 85th Street on-ramp to northbound I-405 via the collector-distributor lane.


This shift is needed to create space for crews to safely rebuild the shoulder and ramp gore pavement. The traffic shift is scheduled to go into effect February 14 and remain in place for approximately two to three months. This work is weather dependent.

### Shoulder and ramp gore rebuild work

Crews will be conducting demolition, grading, paving and roadway excavation work at both ramps as well as the shoulder along northbound I-405 between NE 70th Street and NE 85th Street. During this work, neighbors can expect:

- Nighttime and daytime work
- Heavy equipment, noise and vibrations
- Odors from paving
- Crews communicating in the field
- Backup alarms for safety

This work will continue for approximately two to three months. Crews will work to minimize impacts whenever possible.
