

Spring and Summer Width Restrictions for I-90 Snoqualmie Pass Construction Updated May 28, 2010

[I-90 Lake Easton Vic to Bullfrog Rd - Eastbound](#)

I-90, milepost 70 to 74 eastbound: Beginning at 5:00 am on April 12, 2010 through June 15, 2010, loads exceeding 12 feet wide are prohibited from 6am to 10pm daily. Loads up to 14 feet wide will be allowed each night from 10 pm to 6am ONLY with one front & one rear pilot from I-90, North Bend to Ellensburg, and I-82 to OR border. Interstate Highways Only. **Alternate routes will need to be considered for this period**

I-90, milepost 55 to 58 eastbound and westbound: From April 15, 2010th through October, loads exceeding 14 feet wide will be prohibited on I-90, from milepost 55 to 58 during nighttime hours (approx. 8 pm until 9 am). (No daytime width restrictions are currently planned for the weekends.)

[I-90 Keechelus Dam to Cabin Creek westbound paving project](#)

I-90, milepost 60.2 to 64.2 westbound: From June 14 through July 31, loads exceeding 12 feet wide will be prohibited during nighttime hours from 7 pm to 7 am while paving operations are underway. No daytime width restrictions are currently planned for this project. (No daytime width restrictions are currently planned for the weekends.)

[I-90 Lake Easton to Big Creek Bridge eastbound concrete replacement project](#)

I-90, milepost 69.5 to 80 eastbound and westbound: From September (after the Labor Day holiday) until early November, loads exceeding 12 feet wide will be prohibited on I-90, from milepost 69.5 to 80 eastbound and westbound, except for the following nights: Loads up to 14 feet wide will be allowed Monday night through Thursday nights from 10 pm that night until 6 am the next morning. (Restriction will apply over the weekend.)
