AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELLENSBURG, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE ELLENSBURG MUNICIPAL CODE relating to CHAPTER 4.40 "ACCESS STANDARDS FOR STATE HIGHWAYS" AND AMENDING SECTION 4.40.04; AND CHAPTER 8.42 "SPEED LIMITS" AND AMENDING SECTION 8.42.02.

The City Council of the City of Ellensburg, Washington does hereby ordain:

Section 1. Section 4.40.04 is hereby amended to read as follows

4.40.04 STATE ROUTE 97.

The City of Ellensburg, with concurrence by the Washington State Department of Transportation, hereby establishes that portion of State Route 97 passing through the limits of the City of Ellensburg as a Class III access control facility subject to the provisions listed under Chapter 468-52-040(3) WAC. ~~the following:~~

- 1) ~~That portion of State Route 97 passing through the limits of the City of Ellensburg from mile post 14.16 (Intersection of Cascade Way and SR 97) north to mile post 14.82 as a Class III access control facility subject to the provisions listed under Chapter 468-52-040(3) WAC.~~
- 2) ~~That portion of State Route 97 passing through the limits of the City of Ellensburg from mile post 14.82 north to the City limits as a Class III access control facility subject to the provisions listed under Chapter 468-52-040(3) WAC.~~

8.42.02 SPEED LIMITS.

It is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate such vehicle on any of the following streets or alleys in excess of the following speed within the location described.
