## Join us on June 28 for a public open house on the next phase of SR 520 construction in Seattle

With the Legislature's passage the 2015 Connecting Washington transportation package, the "Rest of the West," which is the segment of SR 520 from Lake Washington to I-5, is now fully funded. WSDOT is preparing for construction to begin by 2018 on the next phase: the West Approach Bridge South (WABS) and a new Montlake lid and land bridge across the highway.

We're sharing design renderings for the next phase of construction and providing updates based on the work we've done with our partner agencies, design professionals, and community stakeholders. Join us on June 28 to learn about:

1. Updated design renderings for the WABS, Montlake lid and land bridge
2. Schedule and next steps for construction (set to begin by 2018), and how to stay informed
3. A look ahead to future phases of the Rest of the West
4. Other topics such as an overview of design-build contracting and planned environmental enhancements
5. An update on current construction of the West Approach Bridge North (WABN)
