

I-405/I-5 to SR 169 Stage 1 - Widening Project

Tukwila Parkway on-ramp to northbound I-405 to close for 14 days this spring

What's happening on I-405 in Tukwila?


This spring, WSDOT is rebuilding the on-ramp from Tukwila Parkway to northbound I-405 as part of the I-405/I-5 to SR 169 Stage 1 Widening Project (Renton Stage 1 - Widening Project). The ramp improvements are a necessary step in widening northbound I-405 from I-5 to SR 167.

Crews will close the on-ramp from Tukwila Parkway to northbound I-405 for up to 14 consecutive days to conduct this work. This will allow WSDOT the opportunity to complete the improvements in the safest and most efficient manner possible.

By fall 2009, crews will open a new lane in each direction on I-405 between I-5 and SR 167.

These improvements are part of the I-405 Master Plan to relieve congestion and improve mobility along I-405. For more information, visit www.wsdot.wa.gov/projects/I405/.

What are the detours?

During the closure, drivers should slow down, use caution and pay close attention to detour signage.

- **Tukwila Parkway - Westbound traffic:** Tukwila Parkway to northbound 61st Avenue S to eastbound Southcenter Boulevard to southbound West Valley Highway (SR 181) to northbound I-405.
- **Tukwila Parkway - Eastbound traffic:** Tukwila Parkway to northbound 66th Avenue S to eastbound Southcenter Boulevard to southbound West Valley Highway (SR 181) to northbound I-405.



Why is the project needed?

The Renton Stage 1 Widening Project involves adding a new lane in each direction on I-405 between I-5 and SR 167 and a new lane on southbound SR 167 between I-405 and SW 41st Street.

The project will relieve traffic at one of the state's most congested interchanges (I-405 and SR 167) and alleviate one of the worst bottlenecks along the I-405 corridor, the drive from Renton to Tukwila.

The Renton Stage 1 Widening Project is expected to be complete in 2010.
