

Birdseye view of baseline design




What we heard

- Provide safer bike/pedestrian travel along E Roanoke St. between Boylston Ave. E and Delmar Dr. E.
- Use runoff to create a water feature, runnel, and/or stream to cover traffic noise (North Capitol Hill slope).
- Provide easy access to lid to encourage ownership (e.g., small entrance from Federal Ave. E).
- Provide places for small-scale activities such as p-patches, gardens, seating and gathering places, view points, a playground and informal/formal entrances.
- Consider activities that will keep eyes-on-the-street. Maintain privacy for neighborhoods (screening, fencing).

Design Opportunities


- Make this a “to” place by terracing the lid to create level areas for community-focused activities such as gardens, p-patches, a playground, picnic areas, seating and viewpoints.
- Acknowledge that this is an important “through” place by creating efficient, safe connections across and around the lid.
- Encourage community ‘ownership’ and eyes-on-the street by providing easy and safe access from the neighborhoods such as a path from the Federal Ave. E street end.
- Maintain privacy for residents by planting street trees and bands of trees for privacy screening.



View locator map




Baseline design



View 1: Looking northeast across the lid from 10th Ave. E








View 2: Looking southeast across the lid from E Roanoke St.
