

# SR 520 Bridge Replacement and HOV Program



Medina to SR 202: Eastside Transit and HOV Project

## Crews to install final 36 girders at 92nd Avenue Northeast

Construction crews will work nights for one week, July 15-19, following the July weekend closure to install the final 36 girders for the entire SR 520 Eastside project.

Beginning Monday, July 15, crews will set the final 36 girders on the 92nd Avenue Northeast lid structure. After setting the girders, crews will work to complete the north side of the lid structure. This work needs to occur at night due to oversize load restrictions which prevent girder transport during the day.

### Details of the work:

- **Date:** Monday, July 15 through Friday, July 19
- **Time:** 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday evening through Friday morning
- **Location:** 92nd Avenue Northeast, north of the SR 520 westbound lanes

### How will crews complete the work?

Crews will haul the girders on site using trucks and to set each girder takes about an hour.

### What can you expect?

Neighbors can expect nighttime noise from trucks and equipment including the crane used to set each girder.

### Next steps:

Once the girders are in place, crews will begin placing the intermediate diaphragms for the deck structure. Crews will work at night for six weeks or until complete.

- **Date:** Monday, July 22 for six weeks or until complete
- **Time:** 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday evening through Friday morning
- **Location:** 92nd Avenue Northeast, north of the SR 520 westbound lanes
