US 2 Route Development Plan: What it is and how it will be used

What is the US 2 Route Development Plan (RDP)?

- Identifies safety and mobility issues along US 2
- Includes a list of improvement projects that was developed based on the project team's analysis of these issues
- Allows for community input and review



What is the purpose of the US 2 RDP study?

- Used by WSDOT and local jurisdictions to identify community supported, prioritized projects
- Represents a joint plan between WSDOT and local partners to address safety and mobility issues on US 2
- Encourages public input and documents community support for the identified improvements
- Includes traffic modeling to show how each proposed project will improve traffic flow and safety along US 2



What happens after the US 2 RDP is published?

- Local jurisdictions can solicit and secure funding for the identified projects
- As funding becomes available, project design, environmental review and construction will follow
