

SR 99 Tunnel Project

Keeping waterfront traffic moving during SR 99 tunnel construction

Crews clearing space for tunnel construction are preparing to reroute six blocks of waterfront traffic from Alaskan Way to a newly improved road beneath the viaduct. The traffic switch – which will happen during the second week in May and last through at least early 2014 – will change ferry access as well as parking and traffic patterns along the waterfront south of Spring Street.
