



# SR 14 Summer Construction

## SR 14 – 6th Street to Bingen – Chip Seal

### Project Information

During the summer of 2015, contractor crews working for the Washington State Department of Transportation will resurface 45 miles of pavement along State Route 14 from Washougal to Bingen.

Crews will repave six miles between 6th Street in Washougal to the Clark County line. The remaining 39 miles from Prindle to Bingen will be resurfaced using hot oil chip seal.

In addition to providing drivers a smoother ride, the work helps WSDOT preserve SR 14 through the Columbia River Gorge.



### What can drivers expect?

- Daytime traffic will alternate through the work zone, and delays of up to 20 minutes are expected.
- There will be five full closures of the highway for work through the tunnels. Traffic will be detoured across to I-84 and back to SR 14 via the Bridge of the Gods and the Hood River Bridge.
- There will be up to three nighttime closures of SR 14 each through downtown Stevenson and Bingen. Notices will be posted in advance.
