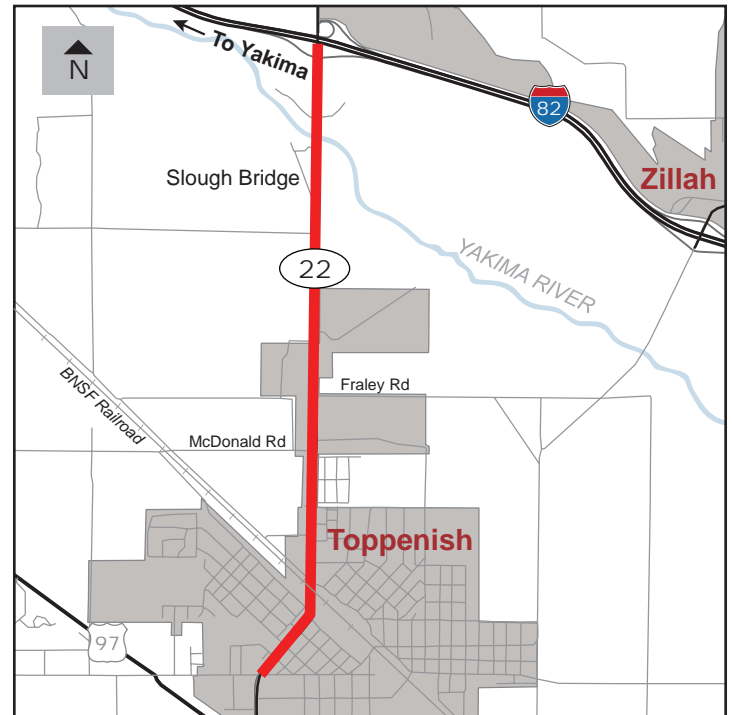

No Parking Zones

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and the City of Toppenish are partnering to improve safety on SR 22 from I-82 to First Avenue. Crews will widen the highway, construct left and right turn lanes at the intersections of Fraley and McDonald Roads, upgrade guardrail and install new sidewalks with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps.

The city of Toppenish passed an ordinance banning parking on the east side of SR 22 from Jefferson Avenue to East McDonald Road, and on the west side of the highway from the Franklin Avenue intersection to North Goldendale Avenue next to Toppenish Middle School. Crews will use the shoulder space previously used for parking to provide the additional width needed for the new turn lanes.

During construction, crews will reduce traffic to one lane. Flaggers will direct drivers through alternating one-way traffic. McDonald Road will be temporarily closed during construction, although a date has not been set. Detour routes will be available through the work zone.
