

## What is a Corridor Study?

WSDOT develops corridor studies in partnership with local agencies to propose project recommendations to address safety and mobility issues along a corridor. The proposed projects are implemented as funding becomes available.

During the development of a corridor plan WSDOT in coordination with local agencies:

- Analyzes existing travel conditions
- Forecasts future travel conditions based on growth and employment trends
- Develops improvement recommendations with planning level cost estimates
- Gathers input from local agencies and communities on transportation issues within the corridor
