

## Where do you live? What areas concern you?

Open House attendees were asked these questions at the two open houses held in March of 2005. WSDOT hosted these open houses to present information about the SR 164 Route Development Plan and get your input on other problem locations and potential solutions. As Open House participants entered the room, they were asked to place a pin on a map, indicating their place of residence - represented by the blue pin. They were also able to offer their written comments about locations along the corridor that concerned them - represented by the red dots.
