

SR 99 Tunnel Project

Waterfront bicycle and pedestrian route changes

Crews clearing space for SR 99 tunnel construction rerouted six blocks of Alaskan Way, including the Elliott Bay Trail, to a newly improved road and shared-use path under the viaduct. The route shown below will remain in place through at least summer 2012. During the morning and evening commute, crews will shift a one-block section of the path between Yesler Way and Columbia Street from the west sidewalk to the east side of the street. The rest of the route, with the exception of occasional changes, will remain in place through early 2014.
