

## SR 520 highway closure June 26-29

June 2015

### Coincides with Pride weekend

Both directions of SR 520 will be closed 11 p.m. Friday, June 26 until 5 a.m. Monday, June 29. All eastbound lanes and ramps will be closed from I-5 to 92nd Avenue Northeast, including the Portage Bay Bridge; all westbound lanes and ramps will be closed from 92nd Avenue Northeast to Montlake Boulevard East.



### Travel options during the closure

There are travel options available to downtown Seattle during this closure, including Sound Transit and King County Metro bus services.
