 - * Accumulated delays are delays later in the day caused by an earlier incident, such as medical, weather, mechanical, or traffic preventing the vessel from catching up to the printed schedule.
 - * Examples of other departure delays are: Vessel congestion at dock, vessel propulsion system, drills, customs delay, terminal dock closure, rescue incident, vessel auxiliary system, etc.
 - * Ongoing construction along the Seattle waterfront and decreased vessel capacity are causing vehicle congestion and affecting OTP on the Seattle routes.
