

Lane restrictions shall be held to a minimum time and length needed for each operation. If the Project Engineer determines that the lane restrictions are causing congestion, the Contractor will be required to open all lanes to traffic until the congestion is eliminated.

Lane, Ramp, and Roadway Closures

Work requiring lane restrictions will be permitted during the following hours:

State Route 3 Northbound and Southbound – Single Lane Closure. See TC21

Single lane closure with one lane open to traffic in each direction in the 3 lane configuration.

Traffic shall be delayed for a maximum of 15 minutes for both directions during the following:

Mon 9:00am to Mon 3:00pm
Tues 9:00am to Tues 3:00pm
Wed 9:00am to Wed 3:00pm
Thurs 9:00am to Thurs 3:00pm
Fri 9:00am to Fri 3:00pm

Signal Turn On. See TC 24

For work to switch traffic from the old signal to the new signal system, traffic shall be delayed for a maximum of 15 minutes in any direction during the following:

Mon 9:00am to Mon 3:00pm
Tues 9:00am to Tues 3:00pm
Wed 9:00am to Wed 3:00pm
Thurs 9:00am to Thurs 3:00pm
Fri 9:00am to Fri 3:00pm

Should high volume hours differ from those specified, as determined by the Project Engineer, the Contractor will be required to adjust the hours of work accordingly. Exceptions to these restrictions may be considered by the Project Engineer on a case by case basis following a written request by the Contractor.

Special events that generate increased traffic volumes through the work area may occur during the life of this project. Lane restrictions will be denied if severe traffic congestion is expected.

Scheduled special events are as follows:

Allyn Days	3 rd weekend in July
Mason County NPRA Rodeo	4 th Friday & Saturday in July
Grapeview Water Festival	4 th Saturday in July
Taste of Hood Canal	2 nd Saturday in August
Oysterfest	1 st weekend in October

There shall be no delay to medical, fire, police, or other emergency vehicles with flashing lights or sirens. The Contractor shall alert all flaggers and personnel of this requirement.
