

**Regional Permit** – is a one-stop-shop concept for oversize/overweight permits. Currently, twelve states; Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Louisiana, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Oregon, Texas, Utah, and Washington are in the compact. The basic premise is to issue a single permit that covers any of the member states affected by a particular move. Regional permit are issued by MCS (Motor Carrier Services) or WTA (Washington Trucking Association).

The vehicles operating on a Regional Oversize/Overweight Permit must comply with the following non-reducible maximum weights and dimensions:

1. Weight:

- 600 pounds per inch of tire width; 21,500 pounds per single axle
- 43,000 pounds per tandem axle;
- 53,000 pounds per tridem (wheel base more than 8 feet but less than 13 feet)
- 160,000 pounds gross weight

In no case may the gross weight exceed the sum of the permitted axle, tandem axle, group axle weights, or the weight specified by the permit, whichever is less.

A minimum of five axles is required for the issuance of a Regional Overweight Permit. Maximum legal weight for a Regional permit is 80,000 lbs regardless of registered weight in each state

Issuing a Regional overweight permit

Type in the first three letters of the company that is requesting the permit.

- Click on the search button
- The system will then refresh (flash) then
- Click the down arrow and select the company

**\*\*Make sure to select the company w/ the same address provided on the application.**

- Select the vehicle that the permit is for from the Issue Permits screen.

**\*\*User can also search for vehicle by License Plate, VIN or Unit number.**

- Select Regional or type the "R" key and Regional will populate the Select Permit field.
- Click the **Proceed** link to move to the next screen.

- Next the user will type in the load description

The user will need to provide a valid start date. User can either highlight the default date and type in the date desired or they can click on the calendar next to the field and select the date.



**\*\*Regional permits cannot be issued for more than five days in advance. \*\***

- Select how the load is being transported.
- Then type in the number of axles on the power unit & trailing unit.
- Next enter in the dimension of the load on the application.

**\*\*The total length of the vehicle combination must be on the permit\*\*\***

In the route description the user will need to type in the highways the customer is traveling for each state.

**NOTE: If the customer is traveling on a highway that is not pre-approved; the user will have to call the state and get an "off route approval". Remember to write down the name of the person giving the approval. (see diagram)**

**Adding Axles Weights**

List the axles, spacings, tire sizes and individual axle weights in order. Here is an example for a six axle combination:

\*tire size not necessary when there are 4 tires on the axles.

At this screen; click in the box next to the state that the permit is for.

In the Mile column the user must enter in the number of miles traveled in each state.

Select the payment type and then click the calculate fee button.

**\*\*\*User must click the calculation button in order for eSNOOPI to display the cost of permit.**

If everything is okay the user can either [add to the cart](#) or issue the permit;

If the user selected the check or cash for a payment type the permit will be issued, but

If the user selected the credit card option the system will then direct the user to the [credit card screen](#); a Bank of America page.
