## Week Two: I-5 Makeover in Seattle June 17 -20

### Lane closures

Three lanes of I-5 southbound close as early as 10 p.m. on Friday, June 17; one through lane on I-5 remains open to traffic, as well as the express lanes.

Express lanes dedicated to southbound I-5 traffic all weekend

Suggested alternate routes: State Route 99 (Aurora Avenue/Alaskan Way Viaduct) or I-405.

### Ramp closures

Howell Street on-ramp to southbound I-5 closes at 10 p.m. on Friday, June 17.

**Signed auto detour:** take Stewart Street to 5th Avenue; turn left to the James Street on-ramp to southbound I-5;

**Signed truck detour:** take Boren Avenue to Fairview Avenue to the Mercer Street on-ramp to southbound I-5

Union Street exit to downtown Seattle closes at 10 p.m. on Friday, June 17.

**Signed detour:** continue on I-5 southbound to the 4th Avenue South exit, northbound on 4th Avenue into downtown

Columbia/James St. exit to downtown Seattle closes at 10 p.m. Friday, June 17.

**Signed detour:** continue on I-5 southbound to the 4th Avenue South exit, northbound on 4th Avenue into downtown

### Anticipated work on I-5 southbound

**Friday night/Saturday morning** – demolish and remove pavement

**Saturday and Sunday** - Install new concrete pavement

**Sunday** – concrete cures (sets). Crews will cut into the concrete to allow space for the concrete to expand and contract without damage

### What else can drivers do to avoid backups?

- Allow extra time to get where you need to go
- Ride the bus or carpool
- Take alternate routes
- Reschedule your trip
- Get real-time traffic information from radio, television and WSDOT's Web site
