



US 2 - Bickford Avenue Intersection Safety Improvements





What is WSDOT planning for the US 2/ Bickford Ave. intersection?

WSDOT plans to build a new overpass at this intersection to provide a safer access to US 2. There have been 13 collisions in the past five years at this intersection that are directly related to drivers turning across traffic. An overpass will allow traffic to cross over US 2 rather than crossing through traffic.
