

Traffic switch from old SR 520 floating bridge to new bridge

Phase 1: **Weekend full highway closure (no sooner than April 8-11)***


LEGEND

Lanes Closed




During the first weekend closure:
All lanes and ramps of the old and new SR 520 floating bridges will be closed between 92nd Ave NE and Montlake Boulevard.
★ The transit stop at Evergreen Point Rd. will be closed.

Phase 2: **The two weeks following first highway closure**




After the first weekend closure:
Westbound traffic will travel on the new floating bridge.
Eastbound traffic will travel on the old floating bridge.
★ The transit stop at Evergreen Point Rd. will remain closed for at least two weeks.

Phase 3: **Second weekend full highway closure (no sooner than April 22-25)***



During the second weekend closure:
All lanes and ramps of the old and new SR 520 floating bridges will be closed between 92nd Ave NE and Montlake Boulevard.
★ The transit stop at Evergreen Point Rd. will remain closed.

Phase 4: **Traffic after second highway closure**



After the second weekend closure:
Eastbound and westbound traffic will travel on the new floating bridge.
The transit stop at Evergreen Point Rd. will reopen.
The old floating bridge will permanently close to traffic.

* Tentative dates for the two weekend closures are April 8-11 and 22-25. Due to the dynamic nature of construction, these dates may change.
