Target Audience

This training is intended for bridge program personnel charged with maintaining correct and current National Bridge Inventory (NBI) coding for the bridges owned by their agency. This course is preparatory for Bridge Condition Inspection Training (BCIT) and it is recommended that this class be taken prior to the BCIT.

Course Description

This course is designed to provide knowledge of the requirements for the correct coding of bridges contained in the National Bridge Inventory (NBI), and is intended for bridge program personnel charged with maintaining correct and current National Bridge Inventory coding for bridges owned by their agency.

This class is primarily for Washington State agencies. The following registration procedures apply:

PRIORITY REGISTRATION: for Washington State Agencies – Free

On-line registration is open now to the following groups on a priority basis through **December 11, 2009**. Use the link below to register.

- Federal Agencies in Washington State
- Consultants currently inspecting bridges in Washington State (residing in-state or out-of-state)

Note to Consultants: Five spaces will be open initially to consultants during priority registration, one person per company, however, please register on-line all those wishing to attend. The first person on your list (as you fill out the on-line form) will be registered, all other names will go on the wait list. On **December 14, 2009**, providing there is space available, all those on the wait list will be put into the class (before the out-of-state group). An e-mail notification will tell you the status of your registration.

OPEN REGISTRATION: for Out-of-State Agencies - \$150

On-line registration is open now for the **wait list**. Use the link below to register. People in these three groups will be placed on a wait list through **December 11, 2009**.

- Agencies from other states
- Federal agencies in other states
- Consultants currently inspecting bridges in other states

You may register now using our on-line registration process; however, your name will be placed on the wait list and you will receive an e-mail notice to this effect. On **December 14, 2009**, provided there is space available, individuals from this group will be moved to the class list on a first registered, first served basis. If your name is added to the class, you will receive an e-mail confirmation. We anticipate that all those wishing to attend this class will be able to do so.
