RESOLUTION NO. 244

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BEAUX ARTS VILLAGE SETTING FORTH A POLICY STATEMENT REGARDING TOLLING ON THE SR-520 AND I-90 FLOATING BRIDGES.

WHEREAS, the 520 Tolling Implementation Committee is evaluating several options for implementing tolls to finance construction of the new SR-520 Floating Bridge; and

WHEREAS, placing tolls on just the SR-520 Floating Bridge alone is likely to increase congestion on the I-90 Floating Bridge; and

WHEREAS, increased congestion on the I-90 Floating Bridge will directly impact traffic patterns in the Town of Beaux Arts Village and the South Bellevue neighborhoods in the Town's vicinity; and

WHEREAS, the impacts on traffic patterns in the Town and its vicinity will have a negative affect on the quality of life of the Town's citizens; and

WHEREAS, placing tolls on both the SR-520 and the I-90 Floating Bridges will eliminate most if not all of said increased congestion on the I-90 Floating Bridge; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Beaux Arts Village as follows;

Section 1. The SR-520 Floating Bridge and the I-90 Floating Bridge should be considered integrated regional facilities for tolling purposes.

Section 2. Tolling of the SR-520 Floating Bridge and the I-90 Floating Bridge should commence concurrently.

Section 3. Only the floating-bridge portion of each corridor should be tolled. There should be no segment tolling on either corridor.

Section 4. All monies generated by tolling should be used exclusively for funding the construction of capital improvements on SR-520, operations and maintenance of SR-520 and I-90 facilities, and mitigation of impacts on local jurisdictions within and immediately adjacent to these corridors.

Section 5. Tolling rates should be the minimum necessary to fund, construct, operate, maintain and mitigate as discussed in Section 4.

Section 6. No tolling revenues should be diverted to transit services or transit rolling stock.

Section 7. All construction funded by these tolls should utilize sound mitigation measures, including quiet pavement, to the extent possible.
