Available truck routes during upcoming SR 99 closure

WSDOT will close the Alaskan Way Viaduct for approximately two weeks to allow Bertha, the SR 99 tunneling machine, to tunnel beneath the structure. WSDOT will provide advance notice of the closure but the start date is not yet known. WSDOT recognizes that closing a major highway will have regional traffic impacts, and is coordinating closely with SDOT and other partner agencies to keep traffic moving.
