

Fares

Passengers must pay the following one-way fares as they board the vessel in West Seattle or at Pier 50 in downtown Seattle.

Adult fares	Seniors (65+) and people with disabilities
\$5.25 – Cash* or ticket \$4.50 – ORCA \$3.50 – ORCA LIFT**	\$2.25 with a Regional Reduced Fare Permit. Fare applies to both cash and ORCA payment.
Youth (6-18) fares	Children (5 and under)
\$5.25 – Cash* or ticket fare \$3.50 – ORCA youth card fare	Free

* We cannot give change to passengers who pay with cash.

**ORCA LIFT card is available to people with household income of less than double the federal poverty level (as established by US Health and Human Services Department). Visit www.orcalift.com or call 206-553-3000 or 800-756-5437 to see if you qualify.

What forms of payment are accepted?

ORCA card. Tap your ORCA card on the card reader held by a crew member. Card must be loaded with a PugetPass or E-purse value. Learn more about ORCA at www.orcacard.com.

Ticket. Purchase an adult-fare ticket from a vending machine at a Water Taxi terminal before boarding. Deposit your ticket in the farebox as you board. Credit or debit cards may be used to purchase tickets.

Passport. Tap your ORCA Passport card on the card reader held by a crew member. Passport covers the full fare on the Water Taxi.

Cash. Exact change is collected at the farebox as you board the vessel. No change or credit can be given. Checks and Metro paper transfers are NOT accepted.



Free Water Taxi shuttles to Seacrest Dock

The King County Water Taxi offers free shuttle service to Seacrest Dock in West Seattle. The shuttles will operate daily offering commute, midday and weekend service throughout the summer.

Route 773 serves the West Seattle junction. Route 775 serves Alki Beach. See the weekday schedules inside this brochure; find the weekend schedules on www.kingcounty.gov/metro or call Metro customer assistance at 206-553-3000.

Pets and service animals

Pets are not allowed on the Water Taxi. Service animals are allowed and ride free.

Accessibility

The King County Water Taxi provides fully accessible walkways and ramps to the vessels at all of our terminals. Wheelchair-accessible restroom facilities are available at each terminal. Changing conditions such as weather and tides may cause challenges in boarding or disembarking our vessels. Please ask any of our uniformed crew for assistance and we will gladly help.

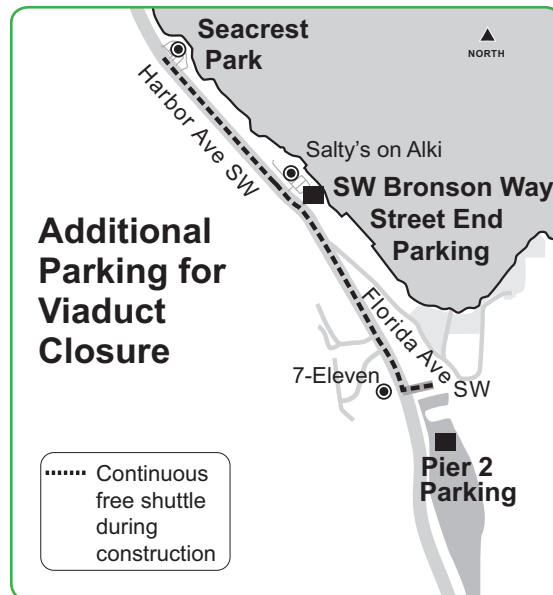
- 10-minute commute from Seacrest Park in West Seattle to downtown Seattle on the new *MV Doc Maynard* with capacity for 278 passengers.
- Higher-capacity vehicles on shuttle routes 773 and 775.
- Additional parking will be available (see details inside):
 - SW Bronson Way and Harbor Ave SW— a total of 160 parking spaces.
 - Pier 2 with a free shuttle connector— 200+ parking spaces for commuters.
- No charge for bikes.

Additional parking during the Alaskan Way Viaduct closure

Harbor Ave SW will have overnight parking restrictions south of Seacrest Park on the southeast (water) side to allow open morning parking for approximately 120 cars.

SW Bronson Way is an unpaved parking area south of Salty's restaurant. It is unmarked, but holds about 40 cars.

The Pier 2 parking lot is a secured parking facility holding more than 200 cars. It will be staffed Monday through Friday, in the morning from 5:45 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. and in the afternoon between 4 p.m. and 7:15 p.m. Cars will not be accessible outside of these hours. We suggest you park here 20 minutes before sailing time. The shuttle will run the .6 mile route continuously between Pier 2 and Seacrest Park.
