



Alaskan Way Viaduct **REPLACEMENT** PROGRAM



Railroad Way South closing Jan 11–14 for viaduct ramp demolition

Last updated: Jan. 8, 2019

What's happening?

This weekend crews will demolish a short section of the ramp connecting northbound SR 99 to the Alaskan Way Viaduct. This work will close Railroad Way South and one southbound lane of First Avenue South. Overhead traffic signal work Saturday night will require intermittent 5-10 minute closures of First Avenue South, and closing a short stretch of the right northbound lane of First Avenue South.

This weekend's construction kicks off approximately three weeks of work around the south portal of the new SR 99 tunnel. Crews will build a new east-west street, South Dearborn Street, that will connect Alaskan Way South with First Avenue South via the intersection where Railroad Way South and First Avenue South meet. This new street and intersection will open when the new SR 99 tunnel opens, scheduled for early February.

Work hours:

- Ramp demolition 9 a.m. – 10 p.m. Sat/Sun, Jan 12-13
- Site prep and clean-up work at all hours, Friday – Mon, Jan 11 – Jan 14
- Nighttime signal work 9 p.m. Sat – 6 a.m. Sun

What will be closed?

- Railroad Way South will be closed 10 pm. Fri, Jan. 11 – 5 a.m. Mon, Jan. 14
- Local access on Railroad Way South will be via South King Street
- A short section of one southbound lane of First Avenue South will also be closed for the weekend
- Section of right lane of northbound First Avenue South at intersection closed 9 p.m. Sat – 6 a.m. Sun, with intermittent 5-10 min. full street closures overnight

What to expect

Demolition will only take place 9 a.m. – 10 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Crews will use machinery to munch ramp structure and drop concrete to ground. Dust will be controlled with water spraying. Noise and intermittent vibration during daytime work, and site illumination as required.


During Sat. night work, crews will use lifts to string overhead wire and install signals for future intersection of First Avenue South and South Dearborn Street. Flaggers will direct traffic when required.
