

Since opening Milepost 31 in December 2011 the AWW program has:

- Completed a 400-foot-long and 80-foot-deep launch pit.
- Named our tunneling machine Bertha, and assembled her in her launch pit.
- Started digging the SR 99 tunnel.
- Welcomed more than 20,000 visitors to Milepost 31 and Pioneer Square.
- Led hundreds of tours to the tunnel site viewing platform.



After you stop at Milepost 31, check out the Pioneer Square tree lighting and dog parade in Nord Alley and Occidental Park.
