Walking Tour: View of the SR 99 Tunnel Launch Pit

Meet at Milepost 31, 211 First Ave. S. in Pioneer Square

Join us for a tour to see SR 99 tunnel crews preparing for the arrival of Bertha, the world's largest tunneling machine. In addition to learning about WSDOT's efforts to replace the viaduct, visitors will be treated to views of this massive project from the lower level of the Alaskan Way Viaduct. Space is limited. Additional tours will be available throughout the spring.

Important information

- The tour is a ½ mile round trip. Visitors must be able walk over uneven ground and climb up and down 50 stairs.
- You must wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes. No sandals, high heels or slip-on shoes allowed.
- No one under the age of 13 is permitted.
- Minors age 13 through 17 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- Women are advised not to wear skirts or dresses.
- All participants must sign a liability waiver on the day of the tour.
- No pets allowed.

The tour may be canceled for any reason. Because the tour is within an active construction zone, we offer guests with limited mobility an opportunity to participate in a self-guided tour along the paved path west of the construction area. Maps are available at Milepost 31 or www.milepost31.org.
