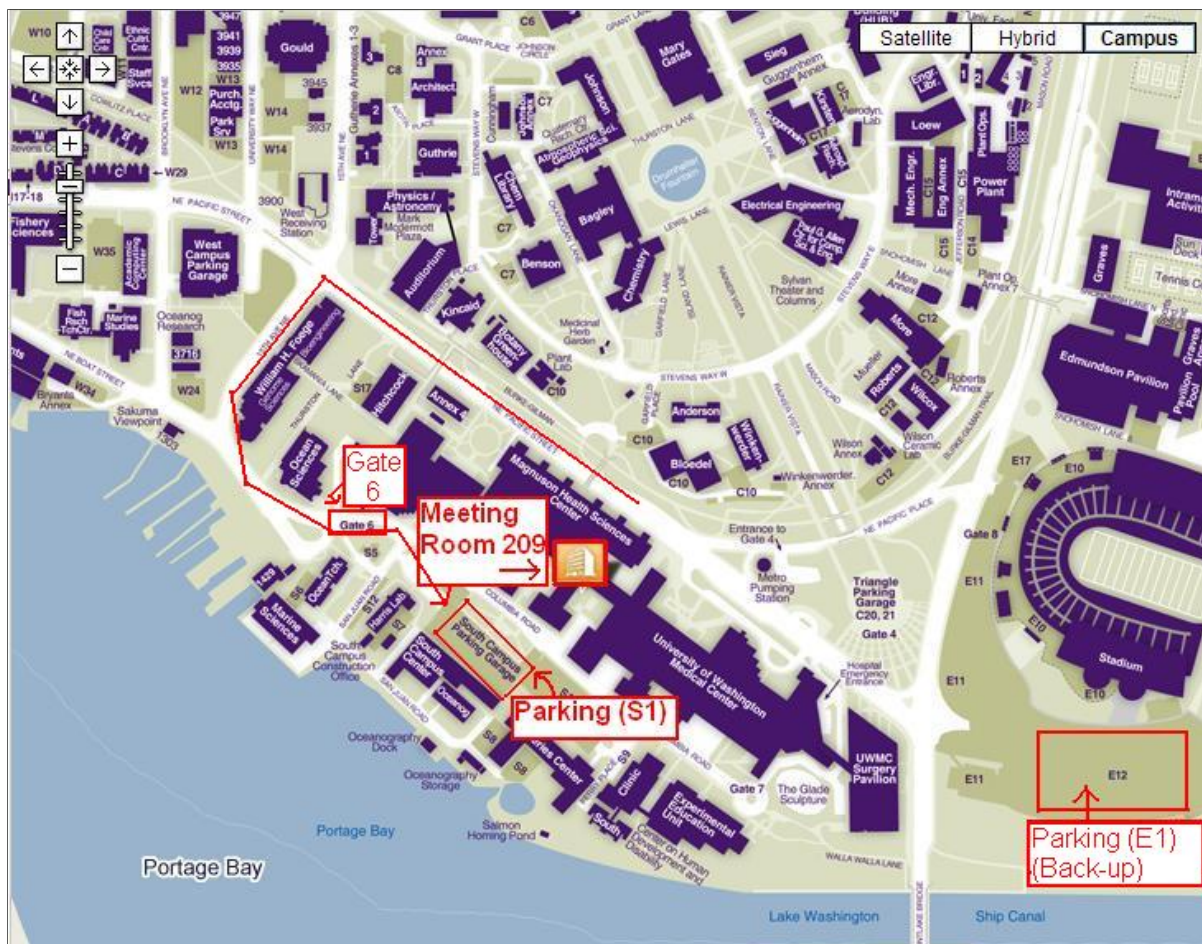


## Floating Bridge and Landings Voluntary Submitters' Meeting Map and Parking Instructions

### Parking Instructions:

The University of Washington (UW) offers a number of paid parking lots on their campus.

Parking space has been arranged at a UW parking area S1 (South Campus Parking Garage), which is located behind the health sciences building. **The preference is to park in the S1 garage, walk up to street level, and follow signs to the meeting room.**

### I-5 to Medina: Bridge Replacement and HOV Project

As S1 sometimes times fills up during the day, additional (back-up) parking is available at parking area E12, which is a large lot just south of Husky Stadium, next to Sound Transit construction.

Per the map above, to get to the S1 garage from Pacific St, turn in on 15<sup>th</sup> Ave NE, then curve left, becoming Columbia Rd. Pay at Gate 6 and enter the S1 garage.

**When speaking with gate attendance at south campus parking gates, you may inform them that you are with the “Washington Transportation” group, under which parking has been confirmed at these two lots.**

You will pay \$15 up front. For any unused time (under approximately 3-4 hours), you may receive a partial refund. With any questions, you may call UW Special Events Parking under UW Commuter Services at 206-616-8710.

Please note that there are several construction projects occurring in the area that sometimes cause congestion. These include:

- Full closure of the 45<sup>th</sup> St. Viaduct (a route from upper UW campus down to U-Village area)
