Project Name: SR 520 PONTOON CONSTRUCTION DESIGN-BUILD PROJECT

(Grays Harbor) Engineer's estimate: DB contract approx \$300 -500 Million CONTAINS CONDITION OF AWARD DBE GOAL: 10%. **Scope of work:** The project requires design and construction of a New Pontoon Casting Facility including ancillary on site support facilities, casting basin, casting basin gate system, hydraulic control structure, launch channel, berm shoreline armoring, concrete batch plant, stormwater and water quality treatment facilities, laydown area and dry storage, on-site access roads, parking, and offices, utilities, railroad spur, and other work. Design and construction of concrete pontoons, 21 longitudinal pontoons 360 ft long by 75 ft wide by 28.5 ft deep, 1 cross pontoon 240 ft long, 75 ft wide by 32.5 ft deep, 1 cross pontoon 240 ft long by 75 ft wide by 34.5 ft deep, 10 supplemental stability pontoons 98 ft long by 60ft wide by 28.5 ft deep. Develop moorage and store completed pontoons until acceptance.
