What's New?

Winter 2016 Sailing Schedule (December 27, 2015 through March 19, 2016) contains these changes from the prior sailing schedule:

- Fauntleroy/Vashon/Southworth**
Construction at Vashon will impact oversized vehicles travelling to Southworth from both Vashon and Fauntleroy. Please note the specific sailing limitations and restrictions for oversized vehicles (tall and long) as denoted by "+" and "x" on the schedules. Fewer sailings on weekends.
- Anacortes/San Juan Islands**
Four vessels in service on weekdays, three vessels in service on weekends.
- Anacortes/Sidney, BC**
No service operated to Sidney, BC.

Understanding Our Schedule

Times are in **color** for morning or late night (a.m.) departures, and in **black** for afternoon/evening (p.m.) departures. Times listed are departure times unless otherwise noted. The schedule begins with the first sailing time for that day and ends with the last sailing time, which may be past midnight and

technically on the following day. Please pay special attention to annotations next to a sailing time.

Holiday Schedules

Weekend schedules are in effect on New Year's Day, Friday, January 1, for the Point Defiance/Tahlequah, Seattle Bainbridge Island, and Mukilteo/Clinton routes. Regular weekday service will be operated on both *Martin Luther King, Jr. Day*, Monday, January 18 and *Presidents Day*, Monday, February 15.

Extra service may be provided for holiday or special event traffic on any of our routes. Please watch for notices on the vessels or at the terminals or contact us via the information on the back panel of this schedule.

Loading

Vehicles should be in line at least 20 minutes prior to scheduled departure time and are loaded in order of arrival with a few exceptions. Reservation routes may require earlier arrival. Refer to your reservation confirmation page for the required arrival time at the terminal. On some routes,

vehicles must be moved often while in line. Washington State Ferries is part of the State Highway System. Using a cell phone while driving on or off the ferry is prohibited by law. WSF is a participant in the WSDOT HERO program. Line cutters into ferry queues may be reported at 877-764-HERO (4376).

Vessels may cease loading two minutes in advance of sailing, except where noted. Walk-on passengers should be on board five minutes prior to scheduled departure time. Security requirements dictate that once loading has begun, the captain's permission is required to disembark the vessel. Unaccompanied vehicles (without drivers) are not permitted.

Vehicles that are over 7'6" in height or over 22' in length, including those with tall antennas, may be loaded out of sequence and must pay a surcharge. Vehicles without 12 inches of clearance from the ground may not be loaded. **Due to construction, limits are in place for oversized vehicle travel to Southworth.**

Bicyclists and persons carrying kayaks or canoes should wait near the front of the loading area, since they normally load first. Crews will

direct passengers on placement of kayaks and canoes.

Once on board, secure bikes in the location provided. When leaving the vessel, please watch for and stay out of the way of vehicles. Shoes with metal sports cleats are not permitted in passenger areas. **Note:** Bicycles on roof racks may count as tall vehicles and be subject to a surcharge.

Only service animals are allowed in terminal buildings or interior cabin spaces on vessels, except for pets in a pet container. However, pets are permitted on the exposed upper decks of vessels on some routes. Ask terminal staff for loading procedures, as vessels and terminals vary. Animals that are not people-friendly should be muzzled or transported in a pet carrier.

Fares

Passenger fares are round trip, with the exception of the Port Townsend/Coupeville route and sailings to/from Sidney, BC. Please refer to the *Passenger and Vehicle Fares* brochure or contact us via the information on the back panel of this schedule. You can pre-purchase your ferry ticket by going to our website. Cash, travelers checks and major credit cards are accepted as payment at the tollbooth. A

receipt will be issued for all sales. If a receipt is not issued, or if there is a discrepancy, please call 206-515-3460, or send a description to the address on the back cover of this schedule, *Attention: Operations Revenue Control.*

We offer seniors, persons with disabilities and passengers with a Medicare card or other eligibility verification travel at half the regular passenger fare. We also offer special rates for youth 6 through 18 years of age. Children 5 and under travel for free.

Safety & Security

Hazardous materials are not allowed aboard a state ferry on scheduled passenger trips except those in compliance with Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to: explosive or incendiary devices, chemical, biological, radiological agents or devices, unlawful or illegally-possessed firearms, and illegal fireworks.

Gasoline may be transported in a vehicle in limited quantities up to 12 gallons total in portable containers, not to exceed six gallons maximum per container. Containers must be UL approved and in good condition. All vehicles must have gas caps.

Regulations require that you shut off and tag all propane tanks prior to boarding, unless

they are the primary fuel source for your vehicle. A limited number of portable propane tanks may be carried in a vehicle in addition to those installed in recreational vehicles. The total amount of propane shall not exceed 100 pounds (water-weight equivalent) whether in a single 100-pound tank or multiple smaller tanks. All propane tanks must be secured and transported in a vehicle.

Transporting a combination of gasoline containers and propane tanks is limited to 12 gallons aggregate for both fuels.

Please turn off your vehicle in the holding lanes. Vehicle emissions can be harmful to the environment as well as to other customers. Vehicle engines must be turned off while the vessel is underway. Do not restart your car until directed by a crew member.



Smoking and e-cigarettes are not allowed on WSF vessels. All smoking materials must be extinguished before boarding the vessel. No smoking is allowed within 25 feet of the entry to ferry terminal buildings.

Security regulations require that all passengers and vehicles are subject to possible security screening.

Travel with a Reservation

Reservations are available on the Port Townsend/Coupeville and San Juan Islands routes. Make a vehicle reservation by visiting: wsdot.wa.gov/ferries/reservations or contact us at 1-888-808-7977.

Your reservation is not your fare. Missed reservations may be redeemed for standby travel on another same-day sailing from the same terminal. Customers may change or cancel their reservation up to 5 p.m. prior to the day of travel. A no-show fee will be charged for missed reservations not redeemed on the same day from the same terminal.

Best Times to Travel
 Customers can avoid the busiest times and skip long lines by using our online trip planning tools. Find specific "Best Travel Times" on the current schedule page. In general, the busiest travel times are Thursday and Friday evenings westbound, and Sunday afternoons eastbound.

General Notes

Vehicles, bicycles and kayaks must be ticketed and in line at least 20 minutes prior to printed sailing time or they may not be loaded. Vessel loading will stop two minutes prior to departure time.

Reservations Available

Vehicle reservations are available in the San Juan Islands:
 • Westbound: Anacortes to Friday Harbor, Orcas, Lopez and Shaw islands
 • Eastbound: Friday Harbor and Orcas islands to Anacortes*

*Reservations are not available for interisland travel, or eastbound travel from Lopez or Shaw islands to Anacortes.

Note: Where available, reservations are recommended. Reservations must be made at least 3 hours in advance for Anacortes/San Juan Islands. Refer to your reservation confirmation page for the required arrival time at the terminal. See the Plan Your Trip section of this schedule for further information.

Westbound Notes

- Priority for Orcas and Shaw vehicles on 3:05 p.m. weekday departure. Recommend 5:20 p.m. sailing for Lopez vehicles; foot passengers OK.
- No vehicles from Anacortes to Orcas on 9:25 a.m. weekend departure; foot passengers OK.
- Priority for Friday Harbor and Shaw vehicles on 5:20 p.m. weekend departure; space for Lopez drive-up vehicles may be limited; no vehicles from Anacortes to Orcas; foot passengers OK.
- Loads or unloads westbound traffic on eastbound sailing.
