You may travel standby on an earlier or later sailings without penalty if space is available. Reservations may be redeemed with standby travel on another same-day sailing from the same terminal. A no-show fee will be charged for reservations not redeemed on the same day from the same terminal.

### Anacortes / San Juan Islands Notes

Bicyclists, kayakers, and non-reserved vehicles must be ticketed and in line 20 minutes before departure. Reservation holders, refer to your reservation confirmation page for required arrival time. Vehicle space on the ferries is apportioned to each island, so ferries making additional island stops may depart with empty space.

### Anacortes / San Juans / Sidney, BC Notes

\*Reservations are not available for interisland travel, or eastbound travel from Lopez or Shaw islands to Anacortes.  
**Please note:** Where available, reservations are recommended. Reservations must be made at least 2 hours in advance for Anacortes/San Juan Islands and Sidney, BC. Refer to your reservation confirmation page for the required arrival time at the terminal. See the Plan Your Trip section of this schedule for further information.

**International Travel**  
Proof of citizenship is required for entry into Canada and the United States. Passports, Enhanced Driver's Licenses and Nexus Cards are accepted for entrance into Canada for travelers 16 years old and older. Travelers entering the US are required to present a valid Passport, Passport Card or Enhanced Driver's License.

Vehicles and baggage are subject to inspection. Articles you bring into either country are subject to being taxed.  
**Please note:** Individuals with felony or DUI convictions are routinely denied entry into Canada. Also, Canadian law prohibits individuals from bringing guns, mace, pepper spray and other personal defense products into Canada.

**Traveling with Children**  
US and Canadian citizens who are 15-years-old or younger are allowed to travel with just a copy of their birth certificate, as are teens between the ages of 16 and 18 if they are part of an adult-supervised school, religious, cultural or athletic group. If both birth parents are not traveling with children, you must have written authorization from the parent(s) along with a telephone number where they can be reached to verify the authorization or proof of custody. Failure to provide such evidence may make the child inadmissible to Canada.
