RECOMMENDATION AND MOTION:

That the City Council adopt Ordinance No. 3634 relating to "Access to State Highways" and adding a new Section 13.04.090 to the Kennewick Municipal Code providing access management and establishing standards for connection to State highways in Kennewick.

MOTION: I move the adoption of Ordinance No. 3634.

SUMMARY:

In December, 1993, the City Council approved the access management classifications for SR(US)-395 and SR-397 in the City of Kennewick (see attached letter dated December 8, 1993). This process was required as part of SSHB 1671 which passed the 1991 State Legislature. Part of that bill (Section 3, paragraph 3) requires cities to adopt standards for accesses permitting that meet or exceed the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) standards. The attached ordinance allow the Public Works Director to adopt rules and regulations consistent with State law.

The ordinance, in our opinion, will help development within the City by making the City the permitting agents instead of WSDOT. This should speed up the process for development receiving an access permit to those portion of the state highways previously adopted by the Council.

ALTERNATIVES:

None recommended.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Some unknown increase in staff time and associated costs to handle the additional permitting process.

CITY OF KENNEWICK
ORDINANCE NO. 3634

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ACCESS TO STATE HIGHWAYS,
AMENDING SECTIONS 5.56.280 AND 5.56.390, AND ADDING A NEW
SECTION TO CHAPTER 13.04 OF THE KENNEWICK MUNICIPAL CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KENNEWICK, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.56.280 of the Kennewick Municipal Code, be, and the same hereby is,
amended to read as follows:

5.56.280: NEW STREETS: New streets may be constructed by developers at their own
expense, abutting property owners at their own expense, local improvement districts, or the City.
All construction must be in accord with this chapter. New streets shall be connected to State
Highways in accord with KMC 13.04.090 and the rules adopted thereunder. (Ord. 3634 Sec. 1,
1995; Ord. 2788 Sec. 1 (part), 1983; Ord. 1295 Ch. VII Sec. 4, 1965)

Section 2. Section 5.56.390 of the Kennewick Municipal Code, be, and the same hereby is,
amended to read as follows:

5.56.390: DRIVEWAY PERMITS: A single permit may authorize one or more driveways
or approaches along a single frontage. No permit will be issued if the proposed driveway or ap-
proach may impair the use of the street or be unduly dangerous to traffic. All driveway
connections to State Highways must comply with KMC 13.04.090 and the rules adopted
thereunder. (Ord. 3634 Sec. 2, 1995; Ord. 2788 Sec. 1 (part), 1983; Ord. 1295 Ch. IX, Sec. 3,
1965)

Section 3. There is hereby added a new section to Chapter 13.04 of the Kennewick Municipal
Code to read as follows:

13.04.090 ACCESS TO STATE HIGHWAYS: The Director of Public Works shall adopt
rules and regulations consistent with RCW 47.50 and the rules of the Department of
Transportation, WAC 468-51 and 486-52 for the regulation of access to state highways. (Ord.
3634 Sec. 3, 1995)

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage,
approval and publication as required by law.
