



## SR 4 - East of County Line Park - Rockfall Work

### Traffic Impacts

#### What Kind of Traffic Impacts Should You Expect?

Construction is scheduled to begin summer 2008. During construction, motorists should expect timed, full closures of State Route 4 each hour, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., while crews work to stabilize this slope.

At the top of every hour, crews will reopen State Route 4 to traffic for 15 minutes to allow traffic to safely pass through the work zone. Scheduled daily closures are expected to last for approximately 3 weeks, as crews remove loose rock, unstable soil, trees and other debris from this slope.

After the scheduled closures, crews will install rock anchors to hold large rocks in place to further stabilize the rock slope. Motorists should expect up to 20 minute delays during daylight hours, as traffic will be reduced to single lane, alternating directions on State Route 4 for project completion activities.
