ORDINANCE NO. 1192

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SUMAS, WASHINGTON ("CITY"), REGULATING ACCESS TO STATE HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, Section 47.50.030(3) RCW requires the City of Sumas to adopt standards for permitting of access to streets within the city limits that are designated as state highways; and

WHEREAS, standards adopted by the City of Sumas must be consistent with, as well as meet or exceed, the standards promulgated by the Washington State Department of Transportation; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Sumas, Washington as follows:

Section 1. A new chapter is hereby enacted as Chapter 11.20 of the Sumas Municipal Code as follows:

CHAPTER 11.20 STATE HIGHWAY ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

11.20.010 Purpose. This Chapter is intended to establish design and construction standards for access permitting onto streets designated as state highways, consistent with standards adopted by the Washington State Department of Transportation, as required by RCW 47.50.030(3), and to implement a City access permit and administrative process in uniformity with the state access permit and administrative process.

11.20.020 Standards for Access to State Highways. The City of Sumas adopts by reference the provisions encompassed in the Washington State Department of Transportation *Highway Access Management - Access Control Classification System and Standards*, promulgated as Chapter 468-52 WAC under authority of Chapter 47.50 RCW, including all future amendments or additions thereto.

11.20.030 Permitting Process for Access to State Highways.

A. The City of Sumas adopts by reference the provisions encompassed in the Washington State Department of Transportation *Highway Access Management - Access Permits - Administrative Process*, promulgated as Chapter 468-51 WAC under authority of Chapter 47.50 RCW, including all future amendments or additions thereto.

ORDINANCE NO. 1102

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PUMAS, WASHINGTON COUNTY, OREGON, REGARDING ACCESS TO STATE HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, Section 43.030 of the Oregon Revised Statutes provides that the City of Pumas is authorized to regulate the use of state highways within the city limits;

AND WHEREAS, the City of Pumas is desirous of providing for the safe and efficient use of state highways within the city limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Pumas, Oregon, does hereby enact the following ordinance:

CHAPTER 11.01
STATE HIGHWAY ACCESS REGULATIONS

Section 11.01.010. The purpose of this chapter is to regulate the use of state highways within the city limits of Pumas, Oregon, to ensure the safe and efficient use of these highways. This chapter shall be known as the State Highway Access Regulations.

Section 11.01.020. The City Council hereby declares its intent to regulate the use of state highways within the city limits of Pumas, Oregon, to ensure the safe and efficient use of these highways.

Section 11.01.030. The City Council hereby declares its intent to regulate the use of state highways within the city limits of Pumas, Oregon, to ensure the safe and efficient use of these highways.

B. All references to "the Department" or "Department" in said Chapters 468-51 WAC shall refer to the City of Sumas for the purpose of this Chapter of the SMC.


C. The city official responsible for the administration of the access permit program covered by this Chapter shall be the Sumas City Public Works Director.

Section 2. All ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall remain in force from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor, if approved; otherwise, as provided by law, five (5) days after the date of publication.


