### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Established by an act of Congress in 1966, the U.S. Department of Transportation has evolved to become an umbrella agency that shapes, coordinates, and executes policies governing the nation's network of transportation systems. Twelve autonomous agencies make up the department, including the Federal Aviation Administration, Federal Highway Administration, and the Federal Railroad Administration. Beyond its core mandate of increasing transportation safety, enhancing mobility, and supporting economic growth, the cabinet-level department has taken on wider responsibilities in recent years, such as supporting homeland and nation security strategies.

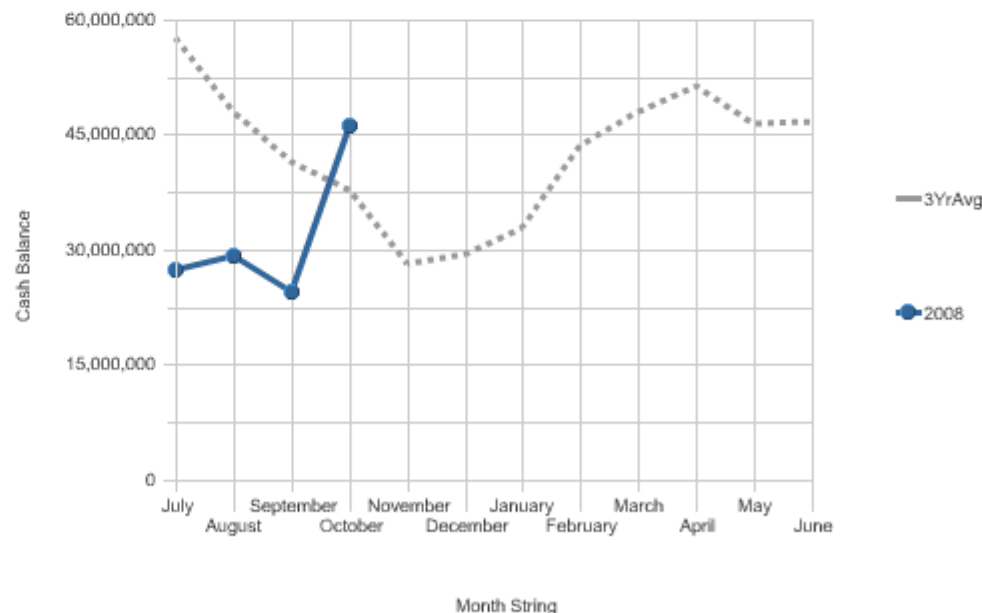

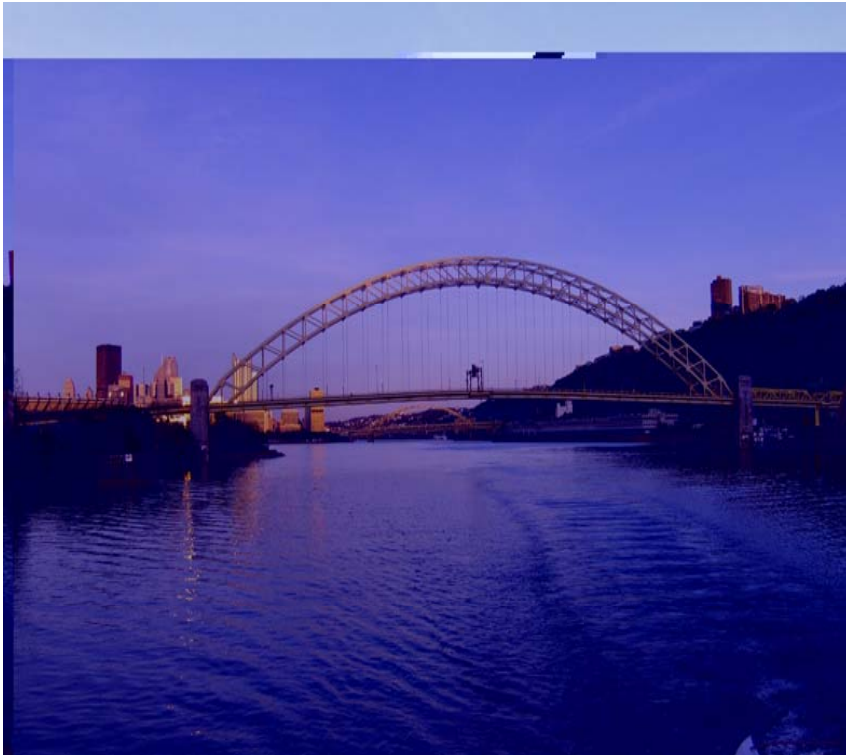

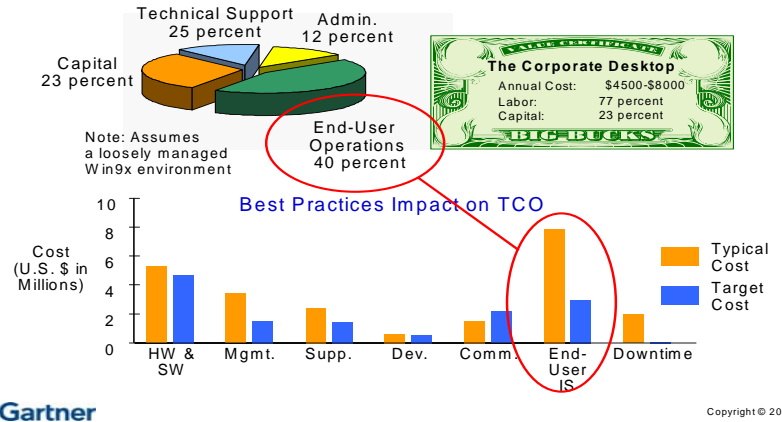
