## Not Working

- Rural – no other transportation alternatives
- Unlicensed drivers continue to drive
- Loss of public transportation (especially in rural areas)
- Lack of consequences when caught
- Cost of drivers ed hinders parents involvement

## Working

- Impound/towing of vehicle

## Suggestions

- Prison system needs to provide services; fill in the gap
- Education of WA driving laws in other languages
- Increase enforcement
- Check points!
- Stop connecting “social” violations to driver’s license (ie; child support) (3)
- Thurston County – has a driving while suspended diversion program with 50% success rate
- Clark County – similar program to Thurston; problem solving court
- Utilize a suspended sticker on license plate
- Skagit County has diversion program we should look at
- Have law enforcement work with high schools (no license = can’t park at school)
- Impound vehicle
- Enhance current impound law
- Connect driver’s license to renewal of car tabs (2)
- Establish a diversion/relicensing program
- Incarceration
- Only suspend for serious traffic violations
- Way to report unlicensed drivers; they drive to DOL to get their license
- Make it a state law; combine charges similar to Minnesota
- Require DWLS offenders to re-take drivers ed
